



## **Festival Dance Academy Dress Code**

Part of the discipline of dance is coming to class prepared, and dressed in the proper attire. We believe our dress code improves the quality of our students' education. By requiring dancewear that is simple and uniform, teachers can more easily see students' bodies and therefore make more accurate corrections regarding movements, positions, and alignment.

**\*Hair should be tightly secured away from the face with clips, ponytail, or bun. \*No Gum! \*No Jewelry!  
\*No Jeans!**

**Creative Dance:** Girls should wear pink footed tights, pink short sleeved, scoop neck leotard, and pink ballet slippers. Pink pull-on skirt or pink skirted leotard is optional.

Boys should wear a plain white t-shirt, black shorts, and black ballet slippers. No tank tops, please.

**Pre-Ballet  
and Ballet 1:**

Girls should wear pink footed tights, pink short sleeved, scoop neck leotard, and pink ballet slippers. Pink pull-on skirt is optional.

Boys should wear a plain white t-shirt, black shorts, and black ballet slippers. No tank tops, please.

**Ballet II –  
Advanced:**

Girls should wear a black leotard, pink footed tights, and stretch or split-sole ballet slippers.

Boys should wear a white t-shirt, black tights, and black ballet slippers. No tank tops, please.

**Pointe:**

Same attire as Ballet II through Advanced, but they are also required to purchase Pointe shoes. These shoes may need to be replaced during the year due to wear and tear. It is very dangerous to dance on pointe shoes that are too worn in and flexible. For a professional fitting, we recommend Empire Dance in Spokane.

**Jazz/Hip Hop:**

Girls should wear any color of leotard, black jazz pants or jazz shorts, and black split-sole jazz shoes.

Boys should wear a t-shirt, black jazz pants or jazz shorts, and black split-sole jazz shoes.

\*\*\*Students may also be asked to buy slip on jazz boots or character shoes, if a particular performance piece requires it. The instructor will notify you in advance.
